MPDC CONDITIONS OF ENTRY POLICY

1. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

These are the terms and conditions under which the Maputo Port Development Company (MPDC) will permit entry of vehicles and persons to and from the Port.

2. ACCESS TO AND FROM THE PORT

- 2.1 Entry to the Port is at your own risk;
- 2.2 The MPDC reserves the right to restrict entry to and control exit from the Port;
- 2.3 Persons desiring access to the Port may apply to the Security Manager for access on the application form available;
- 2.4 Only Authorised Persons and vehicles shall be allowed access to the Port;
- 2.5 The access permit must be displayed on the vehicle window;
- 2.6 All persons who desire access to the Port for non – commercial purposes, shall be in possession of a Port issued identification card;
- 2.7 No authorised person or vehicle may enter or leave the Port, except through the designated entrance and exit gates;
- 2.8 Children are not permitted into the Port;



- 2.9 Animals are not permitted in the Port, except for the purposes of being exported from or imported into Mozambique;
- 2.10 No guns or ammunition of any nature are allowed in the Port, under any circumstance;
- 2.11 The Port has a zero tolerance policy towards alcohol and will conduct random alcohol testing;
- 2.12 No motor cycles or three wheeled scooters are permitted in the operational area;
- 2.13 Taking of photographs is prohibited unless approval is obtained from the Security Manager;
- 2.14 The use of mobile telephones whilst driving is prohibited;
- 2.15 The use of mobile telephones while walking in operational areas is prohibited – find a safe place away from any risk, if you need to make/receive a call;
- 2.16 MPDC reserves the right to search any authorised person or vehicle entering or leaving the Port;
- 2.17 Any authorised person who refuses to submit to a search (as is referred to in clause 2.16 above) shall not be permitted to exit the Port until authorised to do so;



- 2.18 Authorised persons are not permitted to enter operational areas without being escorted and/or trained in the MPDC safety standards;
- 2.19 All road traffic signs and markings, including the speed limit of 30 km/h on the main road and 10km/h in operational areas, in the Port shall be strictly adhered to at all times;
- 2.20 Vehicular traffic in the Port is restricted to the demarcated roadways only;
- 2.21 On entry to the operational area:-
- switched on main lights of vehicle;
 - individuals shall wear high visibility jacket;
 - vehicles entering operational terminals shall be equipped with amber rotating/strobe lights;
 - vehicles shall be in road worthy condition as per Mozambican law.
- 2.22 Agents visiting vessels shall park in the designated parking areas;
- 2.23 No walking in operational areas is permitted, unless authorized and trained in the MPDC safety standards;
- 2.24 The wearing of high visibility garments and closed shoes (no sandals) on entry to the Port is compulsory as well as the

wearing of hard hats on the quayside and/or under suspended loads;

2.25 Any breach of the terms and conditions of entry as mentioned above may lead to access being denied and the vehicle permit withdrawn;

2.26 Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.
